**FORMER BINGHAMTON DEPUTY MAYOR RICHARD DAVID TO
FORMALLY ANNOUNCE CANDIDACY FOR MAYOR ON FEBRUARY 26TH**

-AT ANNOUNCEMENT DAVID WILL DISCUSS EXPERIENCE, EDUCATION AND VISION FOR CITY-

(BINGHAMTON, NY) Former City of Binghamton Deputy Mayor Richard David will officially announce his candidacy for Mayor of the City of Binghamton during a fundraiser/announcement from **7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., Thursday, February 26, 2009 at Terra Cotta, which is located at 81 State Street in downtown Binghamton. (Media Note: David's announcement speech will begin at 8:00 p.m. sharp.)**

“The purpose of my announcement is to reintroduce myself to the residents of the City of Binghamton,” David said. “I also will be discussing my education and professional experience in public administration as well as present the areas I plan to focus on over the course of the campaign. I intend to run a positive, issue oriented, grass-roots campaign and will go door to door to inform residents why I feel I’m the most qualified candidate for the job. My campaign will not focus on the mistakes of Matt Ryan or his administration, but rather I will talk with residents about how I plan to improve City government and services and make Binghamton a better place to live, work and raise a family.”

The fundraiser will include cocktails and hors d’oeuvres. Donation is \$20 per person and \$35 per couple.
